Power Generation Children's Ministry Policy and Procedures

Responsibilities and Obligations of the Parents/Guardians

1. Every child must be escorted to Building 2 by a parent/guardian and signed in.
2. Every child must be signed out by a parent/guardian or previously designated person. Anyone, other than the parent/guardian, bringing/picking up the child from Power Generation must be at least 18 years of age and have parent consent completed in our registration system.
- 3. Every person picking up a child must show photo ID at the time of pick up.**
4. Every child is expected to be on time to Power Generation. Power Generation sign-in begins at 10:45 a.m. on the 2nd, 3rd, and 4th Sundays of each month, unless otherwise communicated. Sign-in will end at 11:15 a.m., at which time we cannot accept any more children.
5. Entry to Power Generation is on a first come, first served basis. Each classroom has a student limit of 15. Once that limit has been reached, the class will be closed to additional students for that day.
6. Every parent/guardian should send their child to Power Generation in comfortable clothing. Some activities may require the child to be physically active.
7. If your child has a medical condition and/or allergy, please notify us immediately.
8. Every parent/guardian is responsible for their child's behavior in Power Generation. There will be consequences for misbehavior, please see attached discipline policy.
9. Every parent/guardian is expected to volunteer with the Power Generation Program at least twice a year.
10. We encourage you to discuss with your child what he or she has learned from Power Generation at least once a week. Weekly lesson reviews instill memorization, discipline, belief of God's Word, and family involvement.
